

Self-Certification Notice of Operation Resumption

I, , certify to the Maryland Department of Health that all of the below conditions for resumption of elective and non-urgent medical procedures have been met on prior to resuming operations on . I understand that failure to comply with the terms of this order shall be considered to constitute unprofessional conduct, and written complaints about such failures may be directed to the Maryland Acupuncture Board. Conditions for resumption of operation are as follows:

- Have at least one week's supply of personal protective equipment (PPE) for providers, staff, and patients, as needed, prior to service
- Social distancing requirements are fully implemented to minimize direct contact between all individuals within all areas of the practice setting
- All providers, staff, patients, and visitors are screened for COVID-19 symptoms upon arrival for shift or visit
- Implementation of enhanced workplace infection control measures are in accordance with the most current CDC guidelines which are outlined in the CCAOM Clinic Infection Control Advisory for acupuncturists
- Any provider and/or staff will stay home if they exhibit COVID-19 symptoms
- A copy of this Self-Certification Notice shall be posted prominently in the facility for the attention of patients and staff
